For your convenience, GreenTeam offers On-Call Cleanup Service!



Up to two times per calendar year, residents of single-family homes may schedule a free on-call cleanup. This is your chance to have us remove from your curb:

- Items weighing up to 70 pounds (except bulky items as described below)
- Household garbage and loose items placed in 32 gallon plastic

bags or sturdy cardboard boxes (2' x 2' x 2').

- Tree prunings and branches up to 3" in diameter and 3' long in securely tied bundles weighing up to 70 pounds (Items must be manageable by one person and take up an area no larger than 6' x 6').

GreenTeam will not collect loose items not bundled, bagged or placed out as described above, dirt, rock, concrete, appliances with Freon, paint, e-waste or other hazardous materials during this cleanup.
